For the C15018 collection HESA has reviewed the Credibility reporting tables as well as the chapters. By doing this HESA has established that two additional chapters are appropriate and two have been removed. Tables previously in New data items or Provider information have now been moved into other chapters.

New chapters:

- Location of employment
- Pay information

Removed chapters:

- New data items
- Provider information

Background

HESA is updating the way in which management information is presented back to HEPs to review and assess the data quality of the submission.

Functionality of the Credibility report allows for there to be more year-on-year comparisons shown on the output tables than has previously been possible in the Check documentation. For C15018 you will now see that more tables have this information available as well as percentage and number differences. These will however be displayed within the data cells rather than in separate columns or rows. Display of these calculations will be controlled using dynamic features that can be toggled on and off within the report view allowing the user to customise their display.
