

## ID 54347: HND to degree bridging courses revised specification

Please note that whilst this requirement only applies to providers in Wales, it has an impact on all providers as it results in the removal of valid entry 01 which is replaced by a new, broader code 00.

	Bridging courses are taken after completing a foundation degree or, additionally for providers in Wales, an HND to enable students to join the final year of an honours degree. They are short courses which are not an integral part of the course they are bridging from, although progression from a successful completion of the bridging course to the final year of an honours degree is assured.  Where a student's studies include, within the same Engagement, a foundation degree to degree bridging course, this bridging course element will be shown by valid entry 02 in CourseDelivery.BRIDGE and an increased FTE in StudentCourseSession.STULOAD as applicable.  For providers in Wales, where a student's studies include, within the same Engagement, an HND to degree bridging course, this bridging course element will be shown by valid entry 03 in CourseDelivery.BRIDGE and an increased FTE in StudentCourseSession.STULOAD as applicable.  If a provider offers a degree bridging course that leads to credits and progresses onto a first degree this would constitute two Course deliveries. The first would have (for example) CourseDelivery.BRIDGE = 02 and an associated qualification aim of credits. The second would have a qualification aim of first degree and so the CourseDelivery.BRIDGE would not need to be returned. The two deliveries could be associated with the same Course entity provided none of the Course level information differs. A	



	student studying on these Course deliveries would have two Student registrations, one associated with each delivery.
