Notes	Full-time With reference to code 01, the funding councils have agreed that a common definition of full-time is that course years must involve a minimum of 24 weeks study and have an average of 21 hours a week study, tuition or work experience (note that this definition does not apply to full-time final year students in providers in Wales or Scotland). Each funding council may also have further additional conditions. HESA will apply the 24 week rule to its definition of full-time in publications i.e. full-time will be all those students coded 01 in this field, together with all those students coded 02 and whose expected length of study is 24 weeks or more.  Accelerated full-time  Code 20 'Accelerated full-time' is only valid for providers in England.  The glossary published in the Regulatory Framework defines an accelerated course as: "A qualification at level 6 of the Framework for Higher Education Qualifications where the number of academic years to be completed is at least one fewer than would normally be	
	the case for that course.
