Background

With the move to discrete collections, statutory customers have agreed that they no longer require a full history of changes for most of the fields that are currently dated.

Therefore, it has been agreed that all of the dates on the personal characteristics will now be removed from the model and the fields moved to the relevant entities, either the Student entity or a new EntryProfile entity.
