


3. Performance against Service Standards








4. Training

Seminars

HESA training is pleased to report record numbers of training seminars and attendees for heidi in the current training programme (2013/14). The increase in demand has undoubtedly been helped by delivering heidi training in London and Edinburgh over the course of the programme.

Since the start of the 2013/14 training programme we have delivered 7 events and trained 113 delegates on heidi user. There are also plans to deliver one final seminar within the current programme as a waiting list currently exists. It should also be noted that heidi training is included within over hands-on training seminars such as 'Planners Introductory' and 'Working with Equality data'. Such events represent over 100 additional delegates who have received training on the system.

Bespoke visits

We have started to promote heidi bespoke visits as an alternative to a mainstream seminar to institutions, especially in the cases of multiple bookings from a single institution. Most institutions recognise that this is a cost efficient way of receiving training on heidi and it also offers a more personalised experience, as the specific nature of that institution is taken into account in terms of the content and exercises. We hope to continue to promote this service during seminars and through the standard e-mail which advertises the mainstream events. HESA to date have had visit bookings for 4 organisations.

Heidi training 2014/15

Looking forward to the next training programme 2014/15 we hope to continue to support the training needs of the sector through continued heidi user seminars with more regional locations. Our provisional plans are to deliver a heidi seminar every quarter in London and one seminar in both Edinburgh and Manchester. If demand in London is greater we hope to be able to support this. There is resource in the team to support any additional events as required as there are now three competent trainers who can deliver these events independently which allows us to be more reactive to the needs of the sector.

In terms of the material, this has already been progressed in the current programme to extend to strategic thinking behind the use of the data (which mirrors the concept of our new 'HESA for Planners' courses). This has been well received and there are plans to develop the heidi user seminar content again in the next programme to incorporate this approach more extensively.
